Vendor pricing was discussed briefly, this was tabled until the next meeting so that some research could be done on what other fairs do.

Allan will do storage again this year; he did say that this would be his last year. Discussion on increasing rent for anything that is currently under \$50.00 to increase to a minimum of \$50.00. M/M/S Mark Fleck, Wendy Boehm. Motion passed with one no vote per a roll call vote.

Karla brought up concerns that some of our local families had with the vote from the previous meeting to change the open beef show to Sunday.
