

Camping Rules for Primitive

1. Primitive camping is reserved per day and is available Tuesday thru Sunday.
1. All camping spots are grass and are NOT on level ground.
2. Only 1 vehicle allowed per camping site. Parking passes and camping registration will be mailed.
3. Absolutely NO camping spaces will be used for parking vehicles and no vehicles will be used as a mobile living structure.
4. Vehicle pass needs to be displayed clearly at all times.
5. Primitive spots are available on a first come first served basis. Spots are not sold as a reserved spot. Primitive camping is allowed in designated area only.
6. Any primitive camper set up in any area other than their designated area, will be required to move.
7. **ABSOLUTELY NO OPEN FIRES OR FIRE RINGS ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.**
8. **QUIET TIME IS 12:30 to 7:00 a.m.**
9. **CAMPERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP THEIR GARBAGE, WE NEED TO KEEP OUR FAIRGROUNDS LOOKING BEAUTIFUL!!!**

ANY CAMPER FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF ANY CAMPING OR FAIRGROUND RULES, INCORRECT CAMPING LOCATION OR PEDSTAL OR CONNECTED TO INCORRECT ELECTRICAL AMPERAGE CAN AND WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PROPERTY AT OWNERS EXPENSE AND BANNED FROM ANY FUTURE CAMPING ON THE MORTON COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS. ANY PERSON CAUGHT RESERVING A SPOT FOR A BANNED PERSON WILL ALSO BE BANNED FROM ANY FUTURE CAMPING SPOTS AND WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PREMISES AT OWNERS EXPENSE. A TRESPASS NOTICE WILL BE SERVED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT, SECURITY OR A MORTON COUNTY FAIR BOARD DIRECTOR.
