

Morton County Fair Rules and Regulations

1. The Morton County Fair Board reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations to arbitrarily settle and determine all matter, questions and differences in regard thereto, connected with or incident to the Fair.
2. The Fair Board reserves the right to formulate and announce new rules to meet emergencies that may arise later and during the Fair, and to adjudicate all matters arising from the Fair after it is held.
3. The Fair Board will carefully guard against extortion in any form practiced on patrons of the Fair. A violation of this rule will cause forfeiture of contract and money paid and involve expulsion from the grounds as the management may direct. Any Fair patron purchasing goods from an exhibitor does so at their own risk.
4. The Morton County Fair Board reserves the right to prescribe the dimensions and regulate the position of all signs and booths and generally to direct the arrangements of articles on exhibition so far as the same may be necessary to secure harmony and attractive appearance.
5. No claim for injury to any person or property shall ever be asserted or suit instituted or maintained against Morton County Fair, its officers or their agents, or on behalf of any person, firm or corporation or their agents, representatives, servants or employees having license or privilege to exhibit on the Fairgrounds or occupying space.
6. The Morton County Fair Association and Fair Exhibitors shall not be responsible for injury or damage to any individuals, vehicles, items or animals that are present on the fairgrounds property at any time.
7. Every possible protection and courtesy will be extended to everyone at the Morton County Fair, but the Fair Board shall not be responsible for any loss, theft, breakage or damage of any animal, equipment, exhibits, or personal belongings.
8. No exhibits are to be removed before 2:00p.m. CDT. On Sunday. Anyone who removes exhibits before that time must forfeit all prize money, trophies, ribbons and points. Exhibits not removed by Sunday at 5:30 p.m. CDT. or arrangements made for their removal, will become property of the Morton County Fair.
9. All animal species stalls, pens and cages must be cleared and cleaned of debris once vacated or premiums and points will be withheld.
10. Any individuals found to be in violation of any Morton County Fair Board rules or laws governing disorderly conduct, assault, theft, robbery, or other conduct-related activities will cause forfeiture of contract (if applicable) and money paid for admission and involve expulsion and/or trespassing from the grounds as the Fair Board may direct (NDCC 12.1-31 NDCC 12.1-17, NDCC 12.1-23 & NDCC 12.1-22). We ask that you conduct yourself in a fashion suitable for family-oriented fun. Disorderly conduct, or actions that cause public disruption and behavior that endangers other fair guests will not be permitted.
